## Question 1 - Rule 1-2-art 8/9 field diagram

There is an additional 5 yard box on each side of the substitution box where players can stand with Coaches and be ready to substitute.

## **Question 2 - Rule 4-24-art 11**

If B1 defensive player loses his helmet while Team A has possession, there is an immediate whistle. B1 must leave the field and serve a 30 second penalty.

## Question 3 - Rule 5-4

By rule, if a defensive player hits an opponent's helmet with his stick or body it is a minimum one-minute non-releasable penalty.

## Question 4 - Rule 4-25

After a loose ball technical foul, the offending team may NOT call a timeout.

## Question 5 - Rule 4-25-2 situation

A team in possession of the ball may NOT call a timeout until they have crossed the offensive restraining line.

## Question 6 - Rule 1-9 art 2

It is legal for a player to wear his chin pad over his mouth or loose below his chin as long as the strap is attached to all manufactured attachment points.

## Question 7 - Rule 2-1-1

Can a team substitute its Goalie with a defensive midfielder to better execute a double team or a ten-man ride?

## Question 8 - Rule 2-1-1

May a coach put his legally equipped goalie in their team's offensive half of the field and have 7 field players play defense?

Before the start of a game, may the officials declare that the field is not in playable condition and cancel the game?

## **Question 10 - Rule 1-9-1**

A player's arm pads must cover the elbow.

## Question 11 - Rule 4-5-3 note

Team B is man down. A1 shoots the ball. Ball is in flight as the clock shows :00 and horn sounds ending the period. The goalie catches the ball after the horn sounds. How is the next period started?

#### Question 12 - Rule 4-14-1 situation B

The 10-second count is on for Team A when A1 throws, carries or passes the ball into his defensive half of the field. Is this over and back?

#### Question 13 - Rule 4-5-3 situation B

B1 is in the penalty box. A1 throws a pass. While the ball is in flight, the clock shows :00 and the horn sounds ending the period. A2 catches the ball before the official blows his whistle. How is the next period started??

## Question 19 - Rule 5-4-2 situation

B1 has possession. A1 initiates an excessive, violent or uncontrolled slash to A1's head or neck area. Ruling:?

## **Question 20 - Rule 5-9-3**

An Unnecessary Roughness call may be made on an otherwise legal body check if the check was avoidable, deliberate or excessively violent.?

Unnecessary Roughness can be either a releasable or non-releasable time serving penalty

A1 has possession of the ball and A2 is attempting to set a pick. A2 is not motionless, his feet are wider than shoulder width and A2's stick is parallel to the ground. B1, seeing A2's feeble attempt to set a pick, runs around A2 and continues to defend A1. No contact was made with A2. Ruling:

Goalkeeper B1 is out of the crease clearing the ball. A1 legally checks B1's stick causing a loose ball and causing B1's stick to break. A1 gains possession. What should the officials do?

#### Question 31- Rule 7-6-4 situation b

B1 slashes A1, flag down slow whistle. Team A scores. Immediately after the whistle, officials realize that A2 was offside. Ruling:

## Question 32- Rule 6-3-3 situation A

A1 is within 5 yards of a loose ball. B1 holds A1's crosse with his own crosse, preventing A1 from participating in the play. Ruling:

## Question 33- Rule 6-5 art 2e, 7-2-B 1

B1 is serving a releasable penalty and re-enters the game before the timekeeper releases him. Play stops when Team A scores a goal. Ruling:

#### Question 34- Rule 6-5 art 2e, 7-2-B 1

A1 receives a 30 second penalty. With 10 seconds left on the penalty, the coaches swap A1 out of the box for A2 who will return to the field when the penalty expires. In the 10 seconds remaining on the penalty, A1 substitutes back onto the field, and Team A scores a goal. Ruling:

B1 pushes A1 creating a play-on situation. While the ball is still loose, A2 pushes B2. Ruling:
